FROM FATHER MIKE:

Healing

You might have noticed Jesus' many miracles that focus on healing. Today Jesus heals Simon Peter's mother in law of her fever. We don't know how sick she was but it was keeping her from doing her normal work. We all get sick to various degrees. Sometimes it is just a nuisance and other times it is very serious. It is a good thing to ask for healing, pray for healing, and when appropriate receive the sacrament of healing (anointing of the sick should be done at the first sign of serious illness). What do we do when healing doesn't come our way? That's a tough one and too much for a quick bulletin article. I think it is safe to say that we should keep asking and praying, be resigned to God's ultimate will, join our suffering to Christ, and do the best we can to live as Jesus wants. When sick, we might not be able to serve him as well as we would like, but we just have to do the best we can. Also, keep in mind that no matter if we are healed or not, Jesus loves us infinitely and we should be secure in knowledge of that love.

LENT

The beginning of Lent is a few weeks away, February 22. We are accustomed to sacrificing or giving up things we love to eat, or bad things we should stop doing. I used to give up sweets and such, but it never had the impact as giving up time for God instead. I have found that as my Lenten devotion, I find time I think I don't possible have by sacrificing things I can put off or put on hold for 40 days. I then spend time growing in God. It changes year to year but I have spent time with him and work on myself, by doing a spiritual class, religious devotion, or retreat. I want it to be substantial, not a morsel, but the full meal deal, because God deserves at least that, and I need it. This year we are fortunate enough to have a Lenten Mission at our parish; A three day series, March 6th, 7th, and 8th, where Father John McGrann, from Portland, is coming down to give us one and a half hour class for three consecutive days. He will do an early afternoon block, following a noon mass, specifically designed for spiritual issues more suited to seniors,. In the evening (7-8:30) he will do a different track for those who wish to enrich their spirit to live more fully in hope, without fear and how to get the most out of Mass. That will definitely be my Lenten devotion and blessing this year, and I hope it can be yours too.
